On June 20, 1997, 5 year old Keaton Raphael was diagnosed with Neuroblastoma (cancer of the nervous system) and Keaton was tragically taken too soon by childhood cancer. He courageously fought for his life and earned his Angel's Wings. In memory, Keaton's parents created the Keaton Raphael Memorial and his legacy lives on in thousands of children & families.
