## Keaton's Kiddo Kodiak Rings The Bell!



After more than two years of fierce determination, endless courage, and unwavering resilience, **Keaton's incredible Kiddo Kodiak has officially COMPLETED treatment!** 

Back in the fall of 2023, at just 6 years old, Kodiak bravely began his battle against not one, but **two rare and aggressive cancers**: Mixed Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) and Myelodysplastic Syndrome (MDS), also known as "preleukemia." What started as a few seasonal illnesses quickly turned into a life-changing journey.

Kodiak's Warrior Mom, Tonya, shares:

"We thought we were just going in for a checkup, but they admitted us and started blood transfusions right away. So far, he's had Spider-Man blood, Batman blood, Hulk blood, Superman blood—and we just did Aquaman! We're calling it 'superhero blood' because it makes us strong. I told him God's putting us through a special strength training course—and that's how he understands it."



And what a superhero Kodiak has been! With every step, he's shown inspiring strength, heart, and bravery.

To celebrate this milestone, our Family Navigators had the absolute joy of welcoming Kodiak and his amazing family to our Family Wellness Center for a special **end-of-treatment ice cream party** - topped off with a triumphant ringing of our brand-new Keaton's bell!
